

Delivery POS page overview

POS Dashboard

Similar to the POS screen for vending and market POS, the delivery POS page has a dashboard that includes deep links to the account, route, tax area, commission (if applicable), and last visit.

note: anywhere you see text followed by this symbol > you can click on it to navigate to a new screen

Select the **Last Visit** to view what was delivered and the signed invoice

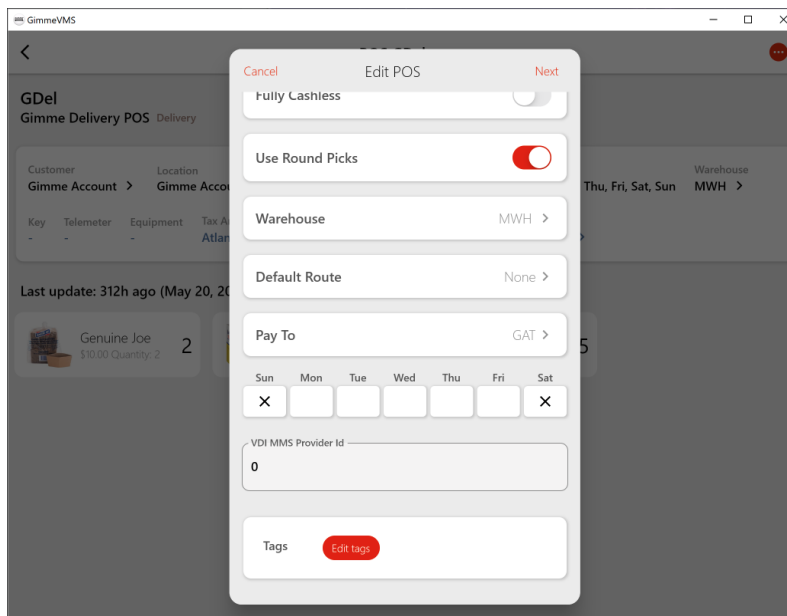
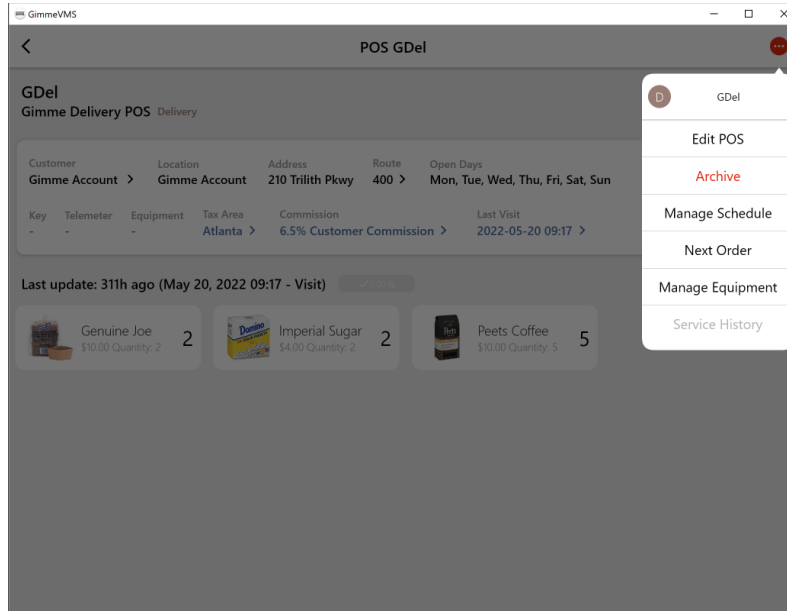

Edit POS Options

- **Open Days** are established during POS creation and can be edited:
 - Select the **red menu button**
 - Select **Edit POS**
 - Scroll to the bottom and click/tap on the days that the POS is unavailable for delivery



- Tags can be useful for reporting purposes. See the article [How to create a tag](#) for instructions
- Assign a **Warehouse** based on the warehouse the product should be deducted from
 - If no warehouse is assigned, product will be deducted from the route's assigned warehouse

Standing Order

- Build a **standing order** by selecting the menu button, then Next Order
- Standing orders are editable from VMS and in Gimme Field when the driver visits the customer
