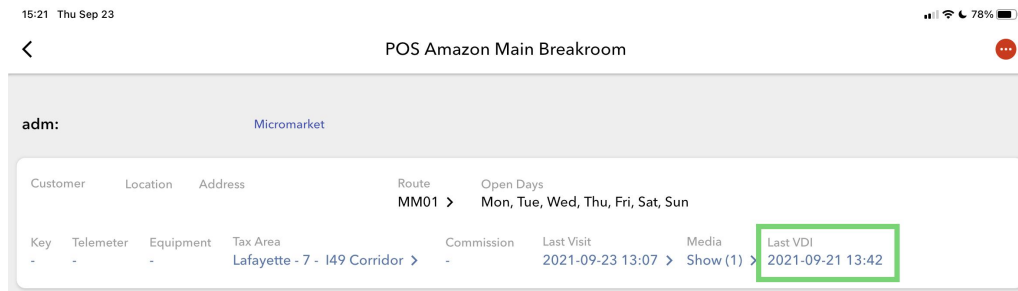


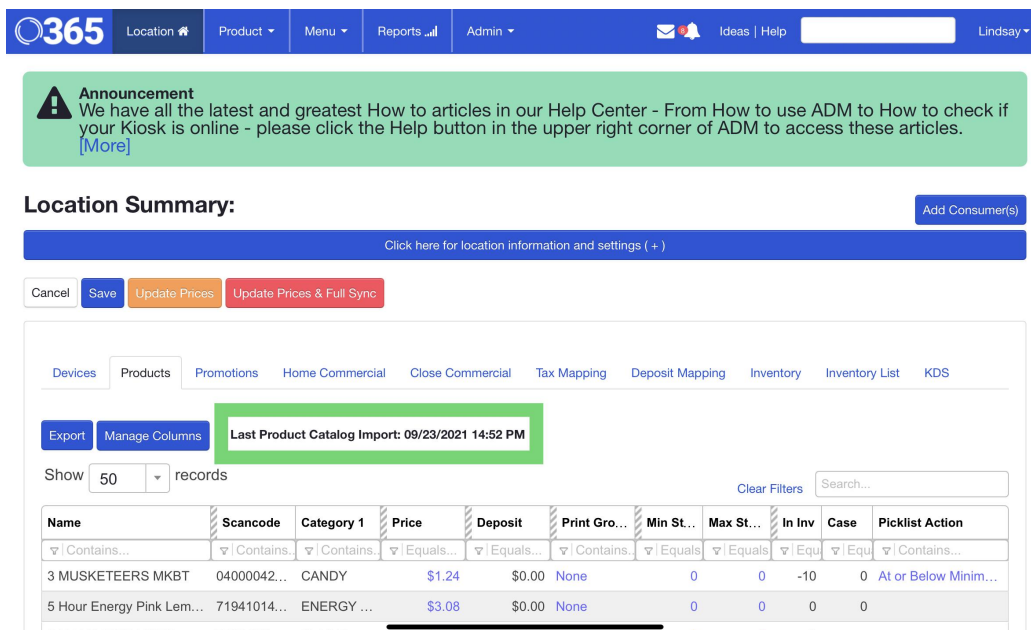
VDI Sync Date and Triggers



This date correlates to the date of the most recent **Full Product Catalog Sync**.

Planogram changes made during the day trigger a full product catalog sync overnight. Planogram changes include adding/removing product, changing the Restock amount, changing a product price, etc. A full product catalog sync is scheduled to run overnight because it typically takes 2-3 hours to complete.

365 displays a **Last Product Catalog Import** date:



This date correlates to the most recent **Partial Product Catalog Sync**.

Unlike the full product catalog sync, a partial product catalog sync typically takes less than 5 minutes. Meaning, when a Gimme VMS user makes a planogram change, 365 should receive the product updates in less than 5 minutes. Gimme VMS can users can quickly add and update products in their VDI enabled 365 markets.
